## **MY DAILY PRAYERS: SPIRITUAL WORDS OF WISDOM VOLUME I**

*Local Business Owner and Anti-Drunk Driving Advocate Channels Pain of Losing Only Child Into a Written Spiritual Journey*

(Austin, Texas) A passionate and gifted speaker, Joyce Adejumo has spoken from classrooms to corporate America to the Senate Chambers at the capitol in Austin, Texas. Adejumo is the Executive Director and spokesperson for The Mitchie Mitchell Foundation, named in honor of her son, Fred Leon "Mitchie" Mitchell III. At the the precious age of three, Mitchie was paralyzed below the waist as a result of his biological father driving drunk and crashing.

Together Mitchie and Joyce used this life-altering event as a way to educate the public, policy makers and DWI offenders about the consequences of drunk driving and its debilitating impact on society. On January 28, 2007, Mitchie died as a result of complications from the 1989 crash. "Since Mitchie's death, our state has lost more than 6848 Texans due to drunk drivers (\*total includes statistics from 2007 and 2008 for Texas only and does not include Texan who died in 2009)." Adejumo stated.

"After months of struggling with the death of my only child, I broke down and released my grip on the pain," states Adejumo. "As God filled my emptiness and dried my tears, these prayers began flowing out of me on a daily basis - and I made a decision to capture them on FACEBOOK and paper knowing there was others going through life's storm and needed assurance that God is by their side regardless." continued Adejumo.

On Saturday, January 30th from 3p-6p, Butterfly Publishing and Adejumo will celebrate the release of her debut book entitled "My Daily Prayers: Spiritual Words of Wisdom, Volume I." The book signing and celebration will feature live Jazz from Sax player Terry Thomas and complimentary hors d'oeuvres from Southern Hospitality Catering and Dining. The event will take place at Mitchie's Gallery, (also named in honor of her son) located at 7801 N. Lamar Blvd Bldg. B Ste. 148, Austin, Texas 78752. The public is invited to attend this free event.
